Summer Youth Corps Crew Members (ages 15-18) receive environmental and job-skills training while working in crews with other high school youth and two crew leaders. Crew members live, work, and play together in this residential program based in parks across Minnesota, where crews will conserve natural spaces and improve access to outdoor recreation.

Make some money! Earn \$425 - \$500/week over the duration of the program.



Live away from home for the summer! Food, transportation, and lodging are provided during this program. Tent camp in parks across Minnesota and neighboring states while working on projects.



Receive environmental and job-skills training! You'll learn how to use conservation tools and complete projects including trail building, introduced plant species removal, campsite improvement, and more!



Explore outdoors! Weekends and evenings are filled with fun activities with your crew such as canoeing, fishing, games, relaxing around the campfire, and visiting historic places.



Join an ASL crew! Since the late 1970s we've run ASL crews during our Summer Youth Corps program. Deaf and hard-of-hearing youth, ASL interpreters, and anyone studying ASL is encouraged to apply.
